What is **personification**?

Personification is when you give human qualities to an object or animal.

It is another writing technique that we can use to engage our reader and make our stories sound really effective!





Example 1

The wind sang her mournful
song through the falling leaves.

This is **personification** because wind cannot sing.

Humans can sing.





Example 2

The rain kissed my cheeks as it fell.

This is **personification** because rain cannot kiss. Humans can kiss.





Example 3

The water beckoned invitingly
to the boiling hot swimmers.

This is **personification** because water cannot beckon.
Humans can beckon.

3. Flowers



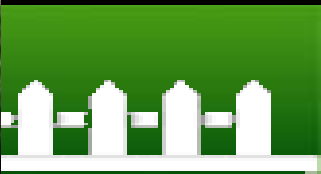
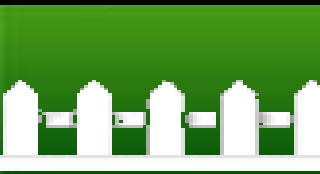
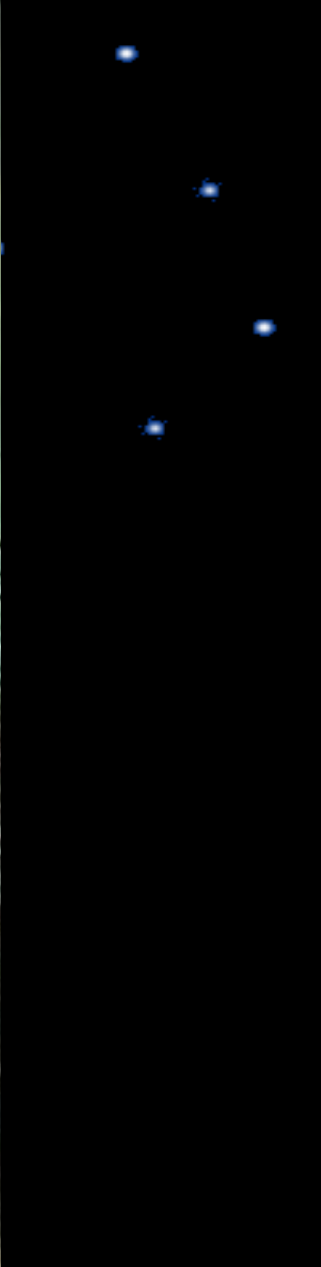
Lightning danced	the camera loves her.
