Literacy Challenge:

Learning intention: Recognises familiar sounds and can copy patterns.

Phonics:

Last half term we looked at different ways to make sounds using your body, called body percussion.

Sing Hickory Dickory Dock. Can you have a go at making the tick-tock sound from the clock, using body percussion? You could clap your hands, click your fingers or tap your knees.

Now have a go at singing the song and add your body percussion. Challenge yourself to keep the same rhythm throughout the song.

Extension: Can you think of any other Nursery rhymes you could add body percussion to?

Mathematical Challenge:

Learning intention: Beginning to present numbers using fingers.

This half term we are going to be learning all about numbers and different ways to represents numbers.

We all have a way we can show different numbers using our fingers. We have 5 fingers on each hand and 10 altogether. Look at this finger counting PDF/PowerPoint, can you practice counting how many fingers you can see?

Extension:

Can you practice showing different numbers using your fingers?

Wider Curricular Challenge:

Learning intention: Can observe plants and use their observations to begin drawing lines and shapes to represent objects.

This half term we are going to be learning all about growing.

Look at the photos of all the different types of flowers. Have a go at drawing your own favourite flower? Look carefully at the shape of the petals and the colour.
