Literacy Challenge:

Learning intention: Understands 'who', 'what', 'where' in simple questions (e.g. Who's that/can? What's that? Where is.?).

During Chinese New Year, people often celebrate by having parades, firework displays and putting up lots of decorations and lanterns. How many of these items can you spot in the attached Chinese New Year Can you find...? poster?

Mathematical Challenge:

Learning intention: Recites some number names in sequence, Joins in singing favourite songs.

Please see the attached PowerPoint and practice singing this song with your child. You could use your fingers or objects such as teddies or building blocks to represent the different numbers.

Wider Curricular Challenge:

Learning intention: Uses movement to express feelings, creates movement in response to music.
